Since September 2024, we have...

Supported 20 people

to **exit exploitation** and begin to safely move forward with their lives on **24 occasions**

20% of these individuals were **British**

Their ages ranged from 20 to 54

65% of the **individuals** were **male**

Nationalities include:
British, Bangladeshi,
Eritrean, Ethiopian,
Guinea, Indonesian,
Iranian, Libyan,
Nigerian, Pakistani,
Sudanese, Vietnamese,
and Yemen

Types of exploitation experienced: forced labour (30%), criminal exploitation (17%), hospitality (17%), sexual exploitation (13%), care visa (13%), debt bondage (4%), domestic servitude (4%).

Provided **189 hours** of casework support, with an average of **7.5 hours per case**

Assisted with 11 referrals to the National Referral Mechanism

Of these, **eight individuals** received **Positive Reasonable Grounds** Decisions

Two individuals received Positive Conclusive Grounds Decisions
